Our Highway Garage Staff did much of the support work for the roadside grading and widening work. There were a total of twenty-four culverts replaced this year. They continued with their various other duties as well (replacing berm, mowing, patching, sign replacement, roadside tree trimming and removal, snow & ice control/removal, etc.).

This year we widened several roads through out the County. Here are some of the roads that were widened: Arrowsmith Rd between SR 49 and Rosedale Rd, Buckskin Rd between Trinity Rd and SR 15, Scott Rd between SR 2 and Cicero Rd and Walnut Grove Rd between Nagel Rd and the Defiance Henry County Line Rd.

We had two bridge replacement this year. Evansport Road Bridge North of Schick Rd. The prime contractor for Evansport was RG Zachrich Construction. The beams and deck were replaced. Bowman Rd near Sponseller Rd was replaced by the Defiance County Highway Crew.

Our administrative staff manages the overall office functions and budget of the Engineer's Office. They also help with the designing, engineering and overseeing of all aspects of the construction projects. With their diligence, we were able to obtain \$2,076,132.00 in federal
