

## **Bare-Root Fruit Tree Seedling Sale**

The District is offering a limited number of fruit tree variety packs for purchase (4 trees per pack). These are high quality, grafted, improved varieties selected for our area. The two varieties of apple trees need to be planted within 50 feet of each other as the Buckeye Gala requires cross-pollination. The peach and pear trees do not need to be planted in close proximity as they are self-pollinating. These trees are **bare-root, and approximately 3–4 feet tall.** **Trees are only available in a four-species variety pack at a cost of \$50.00 per pack. The trees will be available for pickup in early April of 2018.**

Included in the variety pack are:

**1 - Golden Delicious Apple (Dwarf):** Sweet and juicy with a hint of spice. This highly productive tree bears the sensational fruit that, when picked at its peak, is better than what you find in supermarkets. An instant favorite for pies, salads, and your taste buds. Cold-hardy and heat-tolerant. One of the most dependable pollinators for other varieties. Ripens in late September. Self-pollinating

**1 - Buckeye Gala Apple (Dwarf):** Beautifully colored this fruit is bright red with distinctively dark red stripes. Great for fresh-eating, cooking, and baking. Keeps up to 7 months in proper storage. Originates in Ohio circa 1994. Ripens mid-late August.

**1 - Contender Peach (Standard):** This exceptionally hardy variety, perfect for northern gardens, consistently yields large crops of sweet, juicy, medium-to-large fruit. Also features lovely pink flowers that bloom and attract bees in spring. Disease-resistant to bacterial spot. Cold-hardy. Freestone. Ripens in mid to late August.

**1 - Honeysweet Pear (Semi-Dwarf):** A tasty pear – just right for eating fresh or canning. This variety is smooth, creamy and as sweet as honey. Tree is moderately disease-resistant to fireblight. Harvest in early September.
